## **OBJECTIVES OF THE SYMPOSIUM**

As a result of the limited options caused by the situation regarding the pandemic, the Society for Materials and Structures Testing of Serbia and the Association of contemporary industry of clay products of Serbia held their Congresses simultaneously on Divcibare in October 2022. The positive experience, reflected in the high level of interest of the professional and scientific public, submission of a considerable number of projects and numerous visitors, promoted the decision to simultaneously organize the two Congresses again.

The DIMK Congress with the International Symposium is a great opportunity for engineers and researchers in the field of building materials and structures from our country, but also from the wider region, to gather and present the results of their research in the past, as well as to exchange experiences. The main goal of this gathering is to communicate the results of current research in Serbia and the countries of the wider region to the professional public through registered papers, as well as to assess the possibility of practical application of new scientific achievements in the field of building materials and structures.

On the other hand, it is expressed the need of producers of clay products to gather at the Congress, exchange experiences in terms of modern production and new technological processes, the possibility of wider application of clay products as well as environmental protection and energy efficiency. All this imposes on the Association the obligation of continuity of holding such an important gathering. The congress will cover topics related to geological research of the raw material base, exploitation, processing of raw materials, technological processes of shaping, drying and baking and process automation. A special area to which the Congress will pay attention is the application of building materials based on clay.

Both Congresses and the International Symposium are an ideal opportunity to exchange experiences, as well as to analyze the results achieved in the previous period and define future directions of development - in order to improve our construction in the field of materials and structures. The symposium should indicate the orientation of the main directions of development in the subject areas, but this is also an opportunity to consider the state of our regulations in these areas and the need for its further harmonization with European norms. The goals of the Symposium are for civil engineers, technologists and experts in other professions engaged in research in the field of materials and structures, as well as the production of construction materials and their application, to summarize research results in these areas. As in previous years, the Symposium will certainly contribute to the progress of the profession and science, as well as the adoption of criteria and methodology of work in the subject areas of construction.
